




DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT



I knew right away that a film would come out of those tears. It's an unexplored topic that deserves attention and is absolutely inspiring.


A child doesn't necessarily come out of a mother's womb. However, the bond between mother and child transcends boundaries of place, time... And age, in this particular scenario. With Gabi and Lola, it just happens and takes everyone by surprise. It completely takes over. At that point, nothing else matters, it's undeniable, unavoidable. Love is **unpredictable**.

I have since become a mother myself, and I know now how motherhood is mostly ugly and painful before it can be pretty. Gabi's journey is anything but easy, yet she allows her heart to take the lead, she lets go of control. I hope she can encourage someone else to do the same.

Cristiane Natale Lola

Cristiane is a talented and diverse artist, who's been in the entertainment industry for over 30 years. Besides acting, she writes and directs big nationwide plays, having adapted several novels by renowned Brazilian writers. Some of her plays and adaptations include "A Bailarina Azul", poem by Cecília Meireles, "O Vendedor de Sonhos" and "O Homem Mais Inteligente da História", both novels by Augusto Cury. Cris also manages some of the biggest theaters in São Paulo, such as Teatro Itália, Teatro Antônio Fagundes and Teatro Corinthians.

Francis Helena first became an actor at the age of 5. In 1997, she gained nationwide recognition for her role in the huge hit "Chiquititas", a Brazilian children's show. She's also a stage actor and has performed in numerous plays.

Currently with over 130 thousand followers on Instagram, Francis's personal project "Cartas para Mim" was selected for the international festival Rio Webfest and she's acted in the feature film "Minha mãe, Sandra", which is in the post production phase and will be released in Brazilian theaters in the near future.

Why should you watch this film?



If I could sum up this film in one word, what would it be?

Overall, this film is about **motherhood** - where it comes from on the inside, how it evolves on the outside. A mother is not born when her baby comes out of her womb. It's a process of transformation.

The main message is that it does not matter who, when or where, love is unavoidable and it can be bigger than anything.
